Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to our Environmental Education Orientation Program this evening. The Cherry Hill School District is one of the few school districts in the state that offers such a comprehensive on-site ecological experience for students. This program is designed to help our students become aware of the conditions and circumstances that influence and affect their environment and the development of all living organisms. It is hoped this experience will increase our students' ability to analyze, discuss, make decisions, and appreciate the aesthetic aspects of the environment.

The Mt. Misery facilities offer separate accommodations for the students during this four/day three/night residency. Meals are served home style in the large dining hall located at the center of the complex. The PTA will pay for all snacks served throughout the week. Recreational areas for basketball and tetherball can be found within the site for the convenience of the participants.

The instructional portion of the program will be handled by the teachers from your child's Learning Community and staff selected by the district. In addition, guest speakers will present special programs on selected evenings.

All educational and transportation costs will be assumed by the Board of Education. Parents or Guardians are asked to pay for the cost of room and board. The cost is **\$255.00** for the four day/three-night residency. Please make checks payable to the **Cherry Hill Board of Education**. Also, there is a **\$10.00** fee required for the T-Shirt. Please make a check payable to **Rosa International Middle School**.

For your convenience, we are providing labeled envelopes for the two separate payments. Please place the medical form and envelopes in the labeled brown envelope from your packet.
