Saturday, April 29, 2017 – 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. – All weather event – Croft Farm

Family Fun Bike Ride – Registration 8 a.m./Ride 9 a.m.

PLEASE CAR POOL from your home/business location

YOUR EVENT-DAY CHECK LIST TO BRING:

- Your table, chairs
- tent/canopy
- long power cords
(Power access must be confirmed in advance with festival producer)
- umbrella
- scissors, tape, stapler, markers, pen/paper
- paperweight/clips
(protection from wind), etc.
- Reusable table cover
- Your refillable water bottle **-NO plastic**
- **water/soda/juice bottles, please.**

***Please avoid single-use items and disposable items; no balloons, silly string, or unnecessary waste.**

ARRIVAL: You must be set up by **9:15 a.m.** Bring a hand-truck or wheelbarrow to haul supplies.

- Check-in at CROFT FARM, main driveway as early as 7:00 a.m.; 100 Bortons Mill Rd. off Brace Rd., Cherry Hill, 08034.
- Absolutely no vehicles permitted on festival driveways after 9:15 a.m. Late arrivals must park in Bancroft lot (see below) and carry supplies to festival site. No exceptions.
- Your Festival site: Event volunteers (green t-shirts) at Bortons Mill Rd at Croft Farm driveway will direct you to your assigned & marked/numbered location and can help you unload; **No driving on grass! A 'GREEN TIP' sign with vendor number marks most sites; Please leave the 'green tip' sign on display.** These signs are re-used.
- DROP OFF booth materials at your space, then park your car for the day. ABSOLUTELY **NO** parking on grass or driveways **while setting up.** Volunteers can oversee your gear.
- Please staff your display and remain at the festival until 2 p.m.; no cars on driveways until deemed safe by festival officials after 2 p.m.

SPONSOR-VENDOR-NON-PROFIT PARKING – ALL DAY – 7 a.m. until event clean-up:

NEW THIS YEAR! No parking in main Croft Farm lot – reserved for our guests!

- **Sponsors-vendors-non-profit groups only: NEW THIS YEAR!** Bancroft OFFICE lot: at Bortons Mill & Brace Rd. – enter across from Challenge Grove gazebo. One-block walk to festival grounds.
No parking or driving on Croft Farm grass. Unload near your spot-then you will be guided to available parking:
- Arts Center back lot (approx. 30 vehicles)- as space allows: absolutely no departure until after 2 p.m.
- BLACKTOP/circular drive/flagpole area – as space allows; in front of CROFT HOUSE (approx. 25 vehicles)

General Information: Please **NO throw-away plastic water-drink bottles for personal use; use a refillable drink bottle.**

- No soliciting beyond your festival space.
- On site: portable rest rooms behind Arts Center, food for purchase, NJ American Water to refill your bottle (food area in front of farm house; EARTH FRIENDLY waste-recycling & FOOD composting (PLEASE respect the EARTH and disposal areas available!))
- REFRAIN from using: plastic bags, plastic water/drink bottles. No Styrofoam
- Croft Farm is **100% smoke-free.**
- **Departure – starts at 2 p.m.** NO cars on festival grounds or driveways until safety established; Obey our STAFF, please. **NO parking on grass.** Dispose/recycle any waste properly or take with you. Leave your site better than you found it.

We reserve the right to revoke festival display privileges and future participation should guidelines not be followed.
