Creative Clay: A Clay Design Workshop

Have fun expressing your creativity with clay! Create projects using coil, slab, and pinch pot techniques. Students will design and create ocarinas (small, flute-like instruments). Students will learn to paint with glazes, and their projects will be ready for pick-up the following week. **\$155 (supplies included).**

August 6 - August 9 (9 AM-12 PM)

Drawing 101

This offering, for artists of all levels, will include the basics of sketching and shading and other drawing techniques. Projects will range from a still life to a self-portrait. Bring your enthusiasm and creativity and the teacher will guide the way. **\$135 (supplies included).**

July 30 - August 2 (1 PM-4 PM)

Watercolor Painting

Come have fun this summer learning the basics of watercolors! Students will learn classic techniques as well as some Chinese brush painting. Students will practice using wet on wet, dry brushing, washes and other techniques of paint application. **\$160 (supplies included).**

Drama and Acting

This workshop provides young actors with a foundation for basic acting skills while building confidence and creativity through the world of live theater. Students will have the opportunity to practice and perform scenes during the course. **\$140 (supplies included).**

Musical Theatre

Students will be introduced to techniques that will help to build stage presence, projection, diction, and acting auditioning skills. This class will help to develop vocal techniques useful in musical theatre. Different musical genres and vocal styles will be explored. Students will also work to develop acting skills through the use of improvisation, theatre games, and exercises. No experience necessary. **\$140 (supplies included).**

August 6 - August 9 (9 AM-12 PM)

Model Rockets & CO₂ Cars - An Applied Technology Workshop

Participants will explore technology through hands on e-designing and fabricating model rockets and CO₂ cars. Students will enjoy learning the basics of rocket and model building in a safe environment. Participants will be instructed in the proper/safe methods of using all the tools and equipment needed. **\$165 (supplies included).**

Photography: Unique Processes and Dark Room Experimentation

Students will learn a variety of unique photographic techniques including Pinhole Photography, Photograms, and Black and White Darkroom Printing. Students will use 35 mm film cameras to take abstract photographs which will be used in their unique projects. This will allow for dark room experimentation. **\$160 (supplies included).**

July 30 - August 2 (9 AM-12 PM)

Plaster Sculpture Techniques

Students will explore two types of plaster sculpture techniques. Projects will include sculpting an animal or figure and carving a free-standing abstract form. Students will learn how to mix, mold, and carve Plaster of Paris, as well as how to make a wire armature and create form with plaster-embedded gauze. Creative thinking and unique ideas are strongly encouraged! **\$160 (supplies included).**

July 30 - August 2 (1PM-4PM)

Digital Photography Workshop

Students will learn the basics of digital photography. Elements of this course include: learning what your camera can do, photo composition, using Photoshop, and when and how to use professional lighting. This class is designed to give amateurs confidence in knowing how to use their cameras. **\$175 (supplies included) but students should bring a DSLR camera.** (A limited number of cameras available for class use only.)

Animation for Beginners

Want to create an animated film? Students who complete this course will learn the photographic techniques needed for stop action animation using the digital process. Students will focus on: camera modes, composition, exposure, and editing using Photoshop. The basics of script writing and storyboarding will be included. Cameras, software, and lighting will be provided. Students must supply their own flash drive in order to save their creation for viewing with friends and families. **\$160 (supplies included).**

August 6 - August 9 (9 AM-12 PM)

Fun with Graphic Design and Photoshop

Participants will learn the basic tools of graphic design using Photoshop software. Lessons will incorporate the users' individual interests in producing their project/s. Students can choose project themes such as music, entertainment, or sports. Design techniques will be introduced so that participants can create a t-shirt design, a CD or DVD cover. **\$160 (supplies included).**

Straight Outta Kitchen

Pancakes & syrup, milk & cookies, bread & butter, students & cooking. In this course, students will learn about the properties of chemical leaveners vs natural leaveners by making biscuits and pizza. Students will practice using a mixer and making homemade pasta and sauce. Students will also use locally grown produce to make a peach cobbler and a tomato, cucumber salad. That's not all! Scientific experiments will be conducted too, including making homemade play dough. **\$150 (supplies included).**

Basic Chess I

The road to learning (or even just playing for fun) begins with the basics. In this course, students will learn how the pieces move, the rules and principles of the game, as well as tactics and strategies. Students will have ample time to play, and their games will be incorporated into lessons to make learning immediately relevant. The instructor will be able to help each player to improve, regardless of his/her ability. **\$135.**

July 30 - August 2 (1 PM-4 PM)

Basic Chess II

In this course, after a quick review of how the pieces move, students will learn tactics and strategies for all three phases of the game: the opening, middle game, and end game. Students will have plenty of time to play, and their games will be incorporated into lessons to make learning immediately relevant. Just as in Chess Basics I, the instructor will be able to help each player improve, regardless of his/her ability. **\$135.**

August 6 - August 9 (9 AM-12 PM)

Fun with Science: Bio Exploration

Want to dive into the living world? Students will explore exciting, biological topics like characteristics of life, cells, DNA, and adaptations. Students will use microscopes and other scientific tools to explore how living things survive. Students will even design their own experiments! **\$150 (supplies included).**
