Dear Parent/Guardian:

In light of increased security protocols implemented at all Cherry Hill Public Schools, as of March 5, 2018, I find it prudent to discuss arrival and dismissal procedure at Rosa.

Arrival at Rosa:

- Arrival for library HW help and/or math help starts at 7:15; students should use the C-Wing entrance or the main entrance.
- If a parent/guardian is dropping off items before school (7am-8am) please use the main entrance; have your photo ID and your student's identification number.
- As students arrive from the morning buses they will be guided to gym (7th or 8th grade) or the café (6th grade). Students may go to the library for HW help or math help if they have a pass.
- All students are dismissed to their Advisories at 7:50 and school promptly begins at 8am.
- If students are arriving late they must enter the building through the main entrance and our attendance staff will give them late documentation to go to class.

Dismissal at Rosa:

- Dismissal happens promptly at 3pm. If you are picking up a student for 3pm dismissal, please park in the parent loop and not in the front of the building (**that space is designated for emergency vehicles and school staff only**).
- Please make an appointment if you need to pick up your student earlier than 3pm. You can do that by calling our main office. If your child is ill our nurse's office will inform our main office and/or attendance office of your arrival (you will still need to provide student ID and photo ID number to pick up).
- If you are picking up a student between 3-4:30 pm you will be asked to provide your child's student ID and your photo ID at the main office.

We are looking forward to your anticipated cooperation as we endeavor to ensure increased safety of all Rosa students. Please contact me if you have any questions.
