Dear Parents/Guardians:

I am very pleased to inform you that the Rosa faculty and administration have planned an overnight trip to Washington, DC for all of our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. The trip will take place Wednesday and Thursday, June 5 and 6, 2019 and will complement our 8<sup>th</sup> grade Individuals & Society curriculum.

This educational trip will be in addition to the traditional 8<sup>th</sup> grade trip to Great Adventures on June 13, 2019. Rosa staff will accompany your children to Washington, DC and will chaperone them through the many stops.

The following is some pertinent information regarding this trip:

- The total cost of the trip will be \$350.00 (please make checks payable to Rosa International Middle School or RIMS). This includes travel, hotel stay, dinner cruise, evening security at the hotel, breakfast buffet, tour guides, two (2) trip t-shirts and dinner on the way home.
- Payment is to be paid in 3 payments on the following dates:
  - December 1, 2018 - \$115.00 with permission and medical forms
  - January 2, 2019 - \$115.00
  - February 1, 2019 - \$120.00
- Money will be collected on the above dates by your child's advisor.
  - Payment in full will be accepted on any of the payment due dates above.
- A tentative itinerary is attached to this letter for your information.
- A mandatory parent meeting has been scheduled for **Monday, November 12, 2018 at 7pm** in the cafeteria to review the trip itinerary, discuss the procedures for the morning of the trip and to address specific trip information.
